- Discuss the duality of Rodrigo Díaz as a historically documented figure and a mythic hero. How does the modernized text present this interplay of history and legend?

- Review the historical context of medieval Spain, from the Visigothic inheritance to Al-Andalus, the Taifa kingdoms, and the Christian resurgence. How does the epic reflect this complex interplay of cultures and conflicts?
  - Analyze how the poem portrays the motivations of medieval rulers (Christian and Muslim), often driven by pragmatism and profit as much as by religion, complicating simplistic narratives of the "Reconquest."
4. **Form, Orality, & Storytelling in a Modernized Context:**
- Discuss the original oral composition techniques of the *Cid*, including irregular line lengths, assonance-based *laisés*, and repeated *epithets*. How effectively does the modernized version retain the "rough riding" rhythm and the sense of oral performance?
  - Examine the impact of presenting the *Romances of the Cid* alongside the epic. How do these folk ballads, with their prequel/sequel function, enrich the narrative and demonstrate the fluidity of the *Cid*'s legend over time?
5. **Ethics, Law, & Social Critique:**
- Analyze the central theme of virtue versus inherited nobility, particularly through the Infantes of Carrión episode. How does the poem critique empty titles and uphold true courage and loyalty?
  - Discuss the two legal systems (Roman-influenced court trial and Germanic trial by combat) depicted in the poem and their interaction in restoring the *Cid*'s honor.

### III. ADVANCED DISCUSSION & RESEARCH PROMPTS

These prompts encourage deep engagement with the text, critical thinking, and interdisciplinary connections suitable for graduate-level seminars or research projects.

- **The Modernization Process:** Perform a close reading of selected passages (e.g., the *Cid*'s exile, the Corpes incident, a battle scene) in both the Modernized and Original Spanish texts. Analyze the specific linguistic changes (vocabulary, grammar, orthography) and discuss the implications of these changes for interpretation, rhythm, and accessibility.
- **Pedagogical Applications of Modernization:** Design a lesson plan or course module that leverages the Modernized Spanish text. How can it be used to introduce students to medieval themes, characters, and narrative structures before (or in conjunction with) the original text? What specific exercises would benefit from the line-by-line correspondence feature?
- **Cultural Transmission and Adaptation:** Discuss how the act of modernizing a medieval text contributes to its ongoing cultural relevance. In what ways does this edition serve to transmit the enduring legacy of *El Cid* to a new generation of Spanish-speaking readers?
- **The "Crib" Debate in Spanish Context:** Reflect on James Fenton's comments about the "crib." How does this Modernized Spanish edition function as a sophisticated "crib" for the Original text, helping students to "understand" before (or alongside) full "understanding" of Old Castilian?
- **Comparing Epic and Romance:** Choose a specific episode or character from the *Cid* epic. Compare its portrayal in the epic poem with its treatment in one or more *Romances of the Cid* included in this volume. Analyze the differences in focus, tone, and characterization, and discuss what these variations reveal about medieval Spanish literary traditions.
